#### **About The Survey**


The Rochester Downtown Partnership (RDP) conducted an initial community survey from 9/9/2022 to 11/30/2022. Respondents were asked about their behaviors and perceptions related to the downtown core of Rochester, NY. The survey was offered in both English and Spanish and was available digitally and in-person. In addition to digital outreach, the RDP conducted 10 in-person events, including tabling at 5 downtown residential buildings, 3 monthly Office Hour drop-in sessions, and 3 interactive downtown WalkShops, where the survey was distributed and promoted. 








